

SC on Self Respect Marriage Act

- The Supreme Court observed that there is no blanket ban on advocates solemnising "self-respect" marriages under Section 7(A) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.
- On January 17, 1968, the Hindu Marriage (Tamil Nadu Amendment)
 Act, 1967, received the President's approval and became the law.
- 3. This amendment modified the Hindu Marriage Act of 1955, by inserting Section 7-A into it.
- 4. However, it was extended only to the state of Tamil Nadu.
- 5. Section 7-A deals with the special provision on "self-respect and secular marriages".
- 6. It legally recognises "any marriage between any two Hindus".
- 7. It can be referred to as **"suyamariyathai" or "seerthiruththa marriage"** or by any other name.



Arvind Subramanian Panel

- 1. The Tamilnadu State government has formed a **five-member** committee under the chairmanship of Arvind Subramanian.
- 2. He is the **former Chief Economic Adviser** to Government of India.
- 3. This panel will study the settlement pattern of Integrated Goods and Services Tax (IGST) to Tamil Nadu.

Survey on nomadic tribes

- This survey conducted on 1,458 families is belonging to four nomadic tribe communities spread across eight districts of Tamil Nadu.
- The report was released at the Madras School of Social Work (MSSW)
 71st Vimukta Day.
- 3. It was the day in which criminal tribes were **Denotified and observed** every year on August 31.
- The study was conducted in 1485 households of the Narikuravar, Boom Boom Mattukaran - Aadiyan, Lambadas, and Kattunaykars in eight districts of Tamil Nadu.
- 5. The communities significantly lacked access to education and government schemes.
- 6. 7% of the children in these families were not enrolled in schools.
- Of the remaining, 53% reported facing discrimination in their schools by classmates and teachers.



ISI Mark for reusable water bottles

- 1. Soon, reusable water bottles and utensils made of various material cannot be sold without the ISI mark in **Tamil Nadu**.
- 2. The **Bureau of Indian Standards** (BIS) has made certification mandatory and developed **mandatory quality control** order for these products to curb sales of substandard products.

Kalaignar Magalir Urimai Thogai Thittam

- 1. The **Tamil Nadu government** is all set to launch the Kalaignar Magalir Urimai Thogai Thittam, **the largest social welfare initiative** aimed at providing **monthly financial assistance**.
- 2. This scheme is set to benefit over **1.06 crore eligible women** who are the **heads of their families.**
- Under this scheme, eligible beneficiaries will receive a monthly sum of Rs 1,000.
- 4. This financial aid will be directly **transferred into the bank accounts** of the beneficiaries.
- 5. To facilitate easy access to the funds, **ATM cards will be issued** to the eligible women, **allowing them to withdraw** the allocated amount as needed.
- Tamil Nadu Chief Minister on September 15, 2023, launched the Kalaignar Magalir Urimai Thittam (Kalaignar Women's Rights Grant Scheme) in Kancheepuram.





Board for Welfare of Adi Dravidars and Tribals

- The Tamil Nadu government has reconstituted its State-level Tribal Welfare Board.
- 2. The Minister for Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare would be the exofficio chairperson of the Board.
- 3. The panel has eight official and 17 non-official members.
- 4. The panel was **constituted in 2007** for the overall development of the Scheduled Tribes in the fields of education, economic development and social welfare.



Poor uptake for adult vaccination wathika

- This survey was conducted by the Association of Physicians of India (API) and Ipsos in 16 cities.
- Among adults aged 50 years and older revealed that the 71% of adults (50 years and above) surveyed were aware of adult vaccination.
- 3. But, only 16% had taken any adult vaccines.

Rare terracotta pot in Vembakottai

- 1. The state archaeology department's excavations in Vembakottai, Virudhunagar are in the second phase.
- A terracotta pot, in which a liquid had been boiled till it overflowed, and a lamp were found in the site.
- 3. Four burial urns, including two which were intact, were found in a Sivasangupatti village four kilometres from the excavation site.
- 4. More than 3,000 artefacts were unearthed in the first phase.
- 5. It was including beads, toys, pots made of terracotta, and thousands of shell bangles.



- The state had secured the top position by attracting FDI amounting to Rs 36,634 crore.
- 3. This is more than the sum of investment received by **Delhi, Karnataka** and Telangana in the first quarter.



Kokborok language

- 1. The Kokborok language issue revolves around the script used for Kokborok, which has been a **decades-old debate in Tripura**.
- 2. Bengali and Roman scripts have been used for Kokborok.

Kokborok Day is celebrated annually in Tripura, to mark the day in 1979 when Kokborok was recognised as an official language of the state, the other being Bengali. Kokborok refers to the group of several languages and their dialects that are spoken by people in Tripura as well as parts of Assam, Mizoram and West Bengal. The first use of Kokborok is said to date back to the records of the Kingdom of Tripura in the 1st Century CE.

3. The demand for Roman script has **gained momentum** in recent years.


Soil Micronutrients' Impact on Human Health

- 1. The paper, titled Soil micronutrients linked to human health in India, was published recently.
- Over 35% of the soil in the country was estimated to be deficient in zinc.
- 3. About 11% estimated to be deficient in iron.
- 4. Higher levels of soil zinc had lower rates of child stunting and underweight.
- 5. Soil zinc availability is associated with an increase in the height of women.

- 6. Soil iron availability is correlated with anaemia among women and haemoglobin levels in both children and women.

- 3. Earlier, the prospect was discussed by the Law Commission, NITI Aayog, and a Parliamentary Standing Committee.

ECI's Turnout Implementation Plan

- In a bid to increase voter turnout in 2024 Lok Sabha elections, the Election Commission of India (EC) has tweaked its usual voter outreach.
- It aims to focus on 10 large states where the turnout was below or slightly higher than the 2019 Lok Sabha election national average.
- 3. It also focusses on **around 250 constituencies** where the figures were below their respective state averages.
- This plan is expected to increase voter participation from the average of 67.4% in 2019.

- A session of both Houses of Parliament will be held from September 18-22 without Question Hour or private members' business.
- Generally, three parliamentary sessions are held in a year -- Budget, Monsoon and Winter sessions.
- 3. The **Constitution does not use** the term "special session".
- 4. The term sometimes refers to sessions the government has convened for **specific occasions**, like **commemorating parliamentary or national milestones.**
- 5. However, Article 352 (Proclamation of Emergency) of the Constitution does refer to a "special sitting of the House".
- 6. For the two Houses to be in session, the **presiding officers** should chair their proceedings.




India's Largest Home-Built Nuclear Plant

- India's first indigenously developed 700 MW nuclear power plant in Gujarat's Kakrapar has started operations at full capacity.
- 2. The **Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited** (NPCIL) is building two 700 MW pressurised heavy water reactors (PHWRs) at Kakrapar.



Inheritance for Void & Voidable Marriages

- 1. The Supreme Court held that a **child born of a void or voidable marriage can inherit the parent's share** in a joint Hindu family property governed by the **Mitakshara law**.
- 2. It also clarified that such a **child would not be entitled to rights** in or to the **property of any other person** in the family.
- 3. A voidable marriage is one that is made invalid by the husband or wife through a decree.
- 4. A void marriage is invalid at the very inception.
- 5. Mitakshara law of succession governing Hindu Undivided Families applies to the whole of India except West Bengal and Assam.
- 6. Section 16 of the Hindu Marriage Act has statutorily conferred legitimacy to children born out of void or voidable marriages.

- 2. It is Known as 'Aarogya Maitri Cube'.
- 3. India has built the product under **project BHISHM Bharat Health** Initiative for Sahyog Hita and Maitri.
- 4. This includes three frames, each accommodating 12 mini-cubes.





Extension of Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana

- 1. The Union Cabinet has given the green light for an extension of the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) to **2025-26**.
- This move will bring the total number of PMUY beneficiaries to 10.35 crore.
- As per the existing modalities of Ujjwala 2.0, the first refill and stove will also be provided free of cost to Ujjwala beneficiaries.
- Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana was launched in Ballia (Uttar Pradesh) on May 1, 2016.
- 5. It aims to provide clean cooking fuel to about 80 million poor households across the country.
- 6. The target was achieved in September 2019.
- Later, PMUY phase-2 was launched in August 2021 with an initial target of 10 million connections, which was achieved by January 2022.
- 8. Subsequently, the government released 6 million more connections under Ujjwala 2.0 till December 2022.
- 9. Now the government has announced a third phase of the scheme.



One Hundred and Twenty-eighth Amendment bill 2023

- The Constitution (One Hundred and Twenty Eighth Amendment) Bill, 2023, seeks to provide a 33% reservation to women in the Lok Sabha and assemblies.
- 2. This can be implemented only **after a delimitation exercise** is completed, using data from the latest census conducted after the passage of the Bill.
- 3. The next delimitation exercise, or redrawing of constituency boundaries, is scheduled to be held in **2026**.



- The bill was officially introduced in the Lok Sabha on September 12, 1996 by the UPA government.
- 5. It was referred to a **Joint Parliamentary Committee** chaired by **Geeta Mukherjee.**
- Women account for almost half of India's 950 million registered voters but make for only 15% of parliament and around 10% of state legislatures.


Elephant Corridors Across India

- The number of elephant corridors in India has risen from 88 in 2010 to 150, a 40% increase.
- 2. The report also notes that **19% of the corridors** have seen a decrease in use, with 10 others requiring restoration due to impairments.

- 3. The youth, **particularly women**, will be equipped with **key digital skills** that are crucial in sustaining oneself in the present job sector.
- 4. The mission will run for a **period of five years.**






Aditya L1 Mission

- 4. The spacecraft will finally be stationed in a **halo orbit around the** Lagrange point 1 (L1) of the Sun-Earth system.
- 5. It is about **1.5 million km** from the Earth.
- 6. The Aditya L-1 will cover its journey to the L1 point in about four months.
- 7. There are essentially seven payloads on the Aditya L-1.
- 8. The mission's main objective is to expand our knowledge of the Sun, and how its radiation, heat, flow of particles, and magnetic fields affect us.
- 9. Lagrange points are the points where gravitational pull of the celestial bodies equals the centripetal force required to keep a smaller third body in orbit.




Indrajaal


Largest Recorded Wildfire






