'Ungalai Thedi, Ungal Ooril' Scheme


- Collectors and senior district-level officials will spend 24 hours (9 a.m. to 9 a.m.) in one taluk on the fourth Wednesday of every month.
- 2. They will review the functioning of various **projects**, **inspect infrastructure** and receive **representations from the public**.
- 3. The officials will spend the forenoon inspecting **primary health centres**, **ration shops, cooperative societies, schools, and government offices**, among others.

18th wildlife sanctuary – Tamilnadu

- The Tamil Nadu government has declared 80,114.80 hectares of reserve forests in Bargur Hills in Erode district, as the Thanthai Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary.
- 2. This stretch of protected forests links the Nilgiris Biosphere Reserve with Cauvery South Wildlife Sanctuary.

'No Caste, No Religion' certificate

- The Madras High Court has stated that, the revenue officials could not issue a 'No Caste, No Religion' certificate.
- 2. They **don't have any power** conferred on them to issue such a certificate.
- 3. Also, such a certificate would have **serious implications** especially in relation to the application of **personal laws** on issues related to **inheritance of property, and of reservation in education and public employment.**
- 4. The **1973 Government Order** only permits a **person to not mention his/her caste or religion** in school certificates.

Check dam in Ponnai river

- The first check dam along Tamil Nadu Andhra Pradesh border across Poonai River, in Vellore was commenced recently.
- 2. Poonai River, also known as thenpennai, is a tributary of Palar.

10 achievements of Tamilnadu government

- 1. State's economic growth 9% contribution to the Indian economy.
- 2. Gross Domestic Product Tamil Nadu has secured the second place.
- 3. State's growth rate 8.19% while the country's growth rate is 7.24%.
- 4. Export Preparedness Index topped the list.
- 5. Export of electronic goods Tamilnadu is ranking first.
- 6. **Industrial investment** Tamil Nadu reach the third position, up from the 14th position.
- 7. Education Tamil Nadu was elevated to the second place.
- 8. Innovative industries secured the first place.
- 9. Contolled Inflation which had fallen to 5.97%
- 10. The 10th achievement of the government is **improvement of status of that women**, young people, persons with disabilities, and persons on the margins and the oppressed.

1. Chief Minister inaugurated Tamil Nadu's first Mini-TIDEL Park in **Villupuram.**



- To promote growth of IT and ITeS sectors in Tier II cities of the state, the government is setting up 7 Neo-TIDEL parks across the State as per the Tamil Nadu budget 2023-2024.
- 3. Mini-TIDEL parks are being established in **Tier II and Tier III towns**, with **eight other such parks** already in development in **Thanjavur**, **Salem**, **Thoothukudi**, **Vellore**, **Karaikudi**, **Namakkal**, **Tirupur and Ooty**.

Mahavir Statue in Tamil Nadu

- 1. **1,000-year-old** stone statue of Thirthangara Mahavir was found at **Manavarayanendal** near **Thiruchuli in Virudhunagar** district.
- 2. Based on the sculpture technique, it is assumed that the statue might belong to the **11th century AD**.



Kotravai sculpture

- 1. Archaeological researchers have discovered an **eighth-century Kotravai** sculpture near **Ulundurpet**.
- 2. They confirmed that it is **1,200 years old** and was **used for worship**.
- 3. The idol is depicted with **eight hands**, indicating its origin in the eighth century during the **Pallava period**.

One-Stop Centers for Disabled Persons – Tamilnadu

- 1. The state **differently-abled welfare department** will soon establish 39 onestop centres (OSCs) at the **sub-divisional level.**
- 2. This is held under the World Bank-funded RIGHTS project.
- 3. RIGHTS stands for **Rehabilitation Initiative for True Human** Advancement Support.

Minority Welfare measures in Tamilnadu 2024

1. Financial assistance:

- The **State govt** would provide financial assistance under **pre-matric** (class I to VIII) scholarship scheme for Muslim girl students facilitated through the Waqf board.
- 2. Education loan:
 - "The Tamil Nadu Minorities Economic Development Corporation, through cooperative banks, will increase the grant given to Muslim girls to 5 lakhs."
- 3. <u>'Pudhumani Penn' scheme</u>:
 - Girls studying in govt-aided minority schools from **sixth to twelfth** standard in **Tamil medium** will be given **Rs 1,000 per month**.
- 4. Legal heir certificates:
 - Action would be taken to issue certificates to the **second wife**, who **was married under Islamic law**, and their sons and daughters.

5. Expiry date:

- There would be **no expiry date** mentioned in religious minority certificates.
- 6. **Permanent recognition:**
 - would be given for **minority educational** institutions.

Rhodamine-B

- Tamil Nadu recently banned the sale and production of cotton candy also known as candy floss.
- 2. This step was taken by the state government after a lab test confirmed **the presence of cancer-causing chemicals**.

- 3. Rhodamine-B is giving **blue**, **pink cotton and green** which is unsafe and substandard for consumption.
- 4. Rhodamine-B or RhB is a chemical commonly used for dyeing in the textile, paper, leather, and paints industry as a colouring agent.



'Tholkudi' scheme hiksha By Swathika

- 1. A new scheme 'Tholkudi' for **development of tribals** that would be implemented over the **next four years**.
- 2. Under the scheme, **basic amenities** such as road facilities, potable water streetlights and permanent houses would be **provided in tribal areas**.
- 3. Dedicated programmes would also be implemented to improve the livelihood of members of the tribal communities as part of this initiative.

Nemmeli Desalination Plant

- 1. Tamil Nadu Chief Minister inaugurated the Nemmeli desalination plant.
- 2. It has a **capacity of 150 million litres per day** (mld), to supply drinking water to 9 lakh residents in various parts of Chennai.
- 3. In India, **Chennai will be the first city** to produce 750MLD water from desalination plants.

National Centre for Ageing

1. India's first National Centre of Ageing commissioned at **Guindy in Chennai.**

Model plot for TN grassland restoration project

- 1. The Tamil Nadu Forest Department in collaboration with the Forest College and Research Institute (FCRI), Mettupalayam, has launched works for setting up a model grass restoration plot in Sirumugai forest range in Coimbatore district.
- The FCRI team has identified one hectare land in **Pethikuttai reserve forest** a dry - deciduous forest area of Sirumugai range for this purpose.
- It will serve as the model plot for the Tamil Nadu Biodiversity Conservation and Greening Project for Climate Change Response (TBGPCCR) for its Meipulam project.

Maghizhchi

- 1. Tamil Nadu State Police is the only police force in the country to allocate funds for providing mental and psychological treatment for police personnel.
- 2. Inaugurating Maghizhchi, a **mental well-being programme** for **police personnel and their families in southern districts and Madurai and Tirunelveli city police** in association with M.S. Chellamuthu Trust and Research Foundation.
- 3. Also said that reimbursement claims for **treatment of deaddiction** were allowed by the police department as per the Government Order.
- 4. "No other State police department has such a programme."





Caste census in Andhra Pradesh

- 1. **Andhra Pradesh** launched a comprehensive caste census on Friday to enumerate all the castes in the state.
- 2. **A special phone app** has been designed by the government to conduct the census.
- Andhra Pradesh has become the second state in the country, after Bihar, to launch such a caste census.



4th National Chilika Bird Festival

- 1. The 4th National Chilika Bird Festival was held in Mangalajodi, Odisha.
- 2. The festival celebrates the **10 lakh winged visitors of 200 species** that visit Mangalajodi **during the winter.**
- 3. Chilika lies in the Central Asian Flyway for birds.
- 4. Mangalajodi, situated in the **North Eastern Part of Chilika**, the largest brackish water lake of Asia, is known as the "**Birds Paradise of Asia**".

India Ageing Report 2023: Jammu Kashmir's Life Expectancy

- 1. This is jointly conducted by the International Institute for Population Sciences and the United Nations Population Fund.
- 2. Jammu Kashmir emerges as a region with **remarkable resilience against** elderly poverty.

- 3. It has mere **4.2% of its aged population** falling below the poverty line.
- Jammu Kashmir stands out with the highest life expectancy after the age of 60.
- 5. Males 20.3%, and females 23.0%, making it the leader in this demographic indicator between 2015-19.



Rehabilitation of Jadung Village BU SWathika

- 1. In a "first-of-its-kind" initiative, the Uttarakhand government has decided to rebuild and rehabilitate Jadung village in Uttarkashi district.
- 2. It was abandoned by the residents since the **1962 Inda-China war**.
- 3. The village has been under the control of the Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP) since then.
- 4. The locality **a cold desert area like Ladakh** has proper road connectivity, making it a potential tourist destination.

Patna Declaration

- 1. A **three-day international workshop** was held in the **Bihar capital** recently.
- It aims to check Illegal hunting of wild and migratory birds and suggest measures to strengthen their conservation efforts in countries falling in the Central Asian Flyway (CAF).




- 3. The declaration talks about the **state's action plan** for conserving the birds with respect to CAF.
- 4. It also aims to **developing strategies** and concerted actions for curbing illegal hunting, taking and trade of birds in the CAF Region.

Kerala's Environment Budget

- 1. In a **first**, the Kerala government has introduced an Environment Budget as a **separate document** along with the **State Budget**.
- 2. It is **evaluating environmental impacts** of budgetary and fiscal policies and integrating environmental concerns into the 'programmes' of the State.
- 3. The sectors selected for the first Environment Budget are agriculture, livestock, fisheries, forests and wildlife, environment, water resources, cooperation, soil survey, and the energy sector.

Tadoba Kawal conservation reserve

- 1. The **Telangana State** declared the corridor area between **Tadoba-Andhari Tiger Reserve and Kawai Tiger Reserve** as a conservation reserve.
- 2. Tadoba-Andhari Tiger Reserve is located in Maharashtra.
- 3. Conservation and community reserves are two more protected areas appended to the **Wildlife Protection Act**, 1972.
- 4. As per the **Section 36(A)** of the Act, the State government may declare any areas owned by it.

Assam's State Fruit

- 1. Assam's unique lemon variety, **Kaji Nemu (Assam lemon)**, was declared as the state fruit.
- 2. Kaji Nemu has already got the **GI tag.**
- 3. It is one of the **best-known fruits** that have **medicinal properties**.
- 4. It's proven that Kaji Nemu **boosts immunity, reduces cholesterol levels** in the human body and makes it stress free.



Smart Gram Panchayat

- 1. The pilot project 'Smart Gram Panchayat: Revolution towards Digitization of Gram Panchayat' was launched recently.
- 2. The aim of the project is to extend **PM-WANI** (Prime Minister 's WiFi Access Network Interface) service in all gram panchayats across Begusarai district in Bihar.
- 3. **Begusarai** has now become the **first district in Bihar** to equip all gram panchayats with WiFi services under PM-WANI.

75th anniversary of Supreme Court

- Supreme Court of India observed the Diamond Jubilee celebration in Delhi.
- During the event, Digital Supreme Court Reports (Digi SCR), Digital Courts 2.0, and a new bilingual website for the Supreme Court were launched.
- 3. The SC came into existence on **26 January 1950** with the coming into force of the Constitution.
- It initially functioned from the old Parliament building where the Federal Court of India sat for 12 years from 1937 to 1950.
- 5. It moved to the present building in New Delhi in 1958.



India's First Hygienic Food Street 'Prasadam'

- Union Health Minister recently inaugurated 'Prasadam,' the nation's first healthy and hygienic food street, in a grand ceremony at Neelkanth Van, Mahakal Lok, Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh.
- Spanning an impressive 939 square meters,"Prasadam" stands as a symbol of holistic development.
- 3. "Prasadam" goes beyond offering a culinary delight. It provides an array of facilities, including a dedicated kids' play area, drinking water facility, CCTV

National Youth Festival

- Prime Minister inaugurated the 27th National Youth Festival at Nashik in Maharashtra.
- 2. He addressed the youth of the nation.
- 3. National Youth Day is celebrated every year to honour the ideals and thoughts of Swami Vivekananda.
- The theme of the National Youth Festival this year is MYBharat-ViksitBharat@2047- By the Youth, For the Youth.
- 5. During the celebration, various states will showcase **cultural programmes of** their diverse cultural heritage.

India's First Dark Sky Park

- 1. The **Pench Tiger Reserve** (PTR) in **Maharashtra** is **India's first Dark Sky Park within a tiger reserve** for earmarking areas around the park that **restrict light pollution** for stargazers to access pristine dark skies.
- 2. Dark Sky Place certification focuses on lighting policy,dark sky-friendly retrofits, outreach and education, and monitoring the night sky.
- 3. This designation positions PTR as a sanctuary where tourists can witness celestial spectacles, shielded from the intrusion of artificial light pollution.
- 4. Pench Tiger Reserve became the **fifth such park in Asia**.

International North-South Transport Corridor (INSTC)

- 1. INSTC is a **7,200-km long multi-mode network** of ship, rail, and road routes.
- 2. The route primarily involves **moving freight from India**, Iran, Azerbaijan, and the Russian Federation via ship, rail, and road.
- The primary objective of the INSTC project is to reduce costs in terms of time and money over the traditional route currently being used.



4. INSTC facilitates smoother transportation of goods, fostering economic growth and enhancing connectivity between the member countries.

Justice Ritu Raj Awasthi Commission

- 1. The Commission, headed by Justice Ritu Raj Awasthi, is in the process of finalizing the report and is to submit soon.
- 2. This Commission is tasked to examine the issues plaguing NRI marriages and strengthen the legal framework concerning international public Jaw and private Jaws.
- 3. The Commission has suggested **stringent measures** to address grave issues such as abandonment of children and wives, impounding of passports, extradition, custody of children, and ill-treatment of wives in NRI marriages.
- 4. The Commission also examined the 2019 bill on the registration of marriages of NRIs and the Foreign Marriage Act.

Cervical Cancer Vaccination

- 1. **Interim budget** announced the government's initiative to promote cervical cancer vaccination among girls **aged 9 to 14**.
- 2. This will involve the **administration of the HPV [Human Papilloma Virus)** vaccine.
- 3. Indian population of **511.4 million women aged 15 years** and older who are potentially susceptible to the disease.
- 4. Cervical cancer ranks as the **second most frequent cancer** among women in India.

Track Child Portal

- 1. The **Ministry of Women and Child Development** has developed the "Track Child Portal".
- It enables tracking of the missing and found children in all States/ UTs including Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, North Eastern States and Jharkhand.
- 3. Further, a portal namely **GHAR GO Home and Re-Unite (Portal for Restoration and Repatriation of Child)** has been developed and launched by NCPCR.

- 1. The Kilkari programme, a **Mobile Health** (m-health) Initiative , was recently launched for beneficiaries in local content in **Gujarat and Maharashtra**.
- 2. 'Kilkari' (meaning 'a baby's gurgle), is a centralized interactive voice response (NR) based mobile health service.

Pradhan Mantri Matsya Kisan Samridhi Sah- Yojana



- 1. The Union Cabinet approved the "Pradhan Mantri Matsya Kisan Samridhi Sah- Yojana (PM-MKSSY)".
- 2. It is a **Central Sector Sub-scheme** under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada scheme.

Renaming of saving schemes





- 1. The central government renamed the Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana to Sukanya Samriddhi Account Scheme, 2024, and the Post Office Time Deposit Scheme to the National Savings Time Deposit Scheme with revised interest rates.
- This Scheme may be called the Sukanya Samriddhi Account (Amendment) Scheme, 2024.
- 3. It shall be deemed to have come into force on January 1, 2024.
- 4. The deposits made in the account on or after the **1st day of January 2024** shall earn interest at the **rate of 8.2%**.

Global Digitalization Milestone

- The "State of India's Digital Economy Report, 2024," was unveiled by the Indian Council for Research on International Economic Relations (ICRIER), a renowned Delhi-based think tank.
- 2. As per the findings, India has cemented its **position as the third-largest digitalized nation** in the world.
- 3. It stands only behind the technological **powerhouses of the United** States of America (USA) and China.

- 1. The Popular online travel agency Booking.com unveiled its 12th Annual Traveller Review Awards 2024 .
- 2. It highlights the Most Welcoming Regions and Cities in India.




- 4. It is followed by Goa, Kerala, Rajasthan, and Uttarakhand.

Rashtriya Udyamita Vikas Pariyojana

- 1. It is specially designed for the beneficiaries of **PM SVANidhi Yojana**.
- 2. This unique National Entrepreneurship Development Project underlines the government's firm commitment to promote employers across the country.
- 3. It aims to equip individuals with **comprehensive entrepreneurship training**, creating job providers rather than job seekers.
- 4. Under the pilot program, street vendors of **10 big cities of the country** will be given a stipend along with training to expand their businesses.

India Unveils Largest Solar-Battery Project

- 1. The Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) has commissioned India's largest solar-battery energy storage system (BESS) in Rajnandgaon, Chhattisgarh.
- 2. This large-scale integration of solar and battery storage represents a pioneering leap in **renewable energy generation and utilization** in India.
- 3. The project addresses peak energy demand by **storing solar energy** during the day and releasing it during evening hours, ensuring grid stability and reliability.

Coltan Deposits in Kenya



1. Kenya has confirmed the discovery of its **first coltan deposits**.

- The Democratic Republic of Congo holds more than 70% of the world's coltan reserves.


Free visa for Indians by Iran

1. **Iran announced** the initiation of **a 15-day visa-free policy for Indian** tourists visiting the country.



- Indian citizens would be allowed to enter Iran with ordinary passports once every six months and with a maximum stay of 15 days which will not be extended.
- 3. Earlier, Vietnam, Thailand, Sri Lanka have also eased visa rules for Indian tourists.
- 4. Sri Lanka has also allowed visa-free entry to visitors from seven countries, including India, China and Russia.

BAPS Hindu Mandir



1. The BAPS Hindu Mandir, **first Hindu stone temple in UAE**, was inaugurated recently.

- 3. The BAPS Hindu Mandir has been built with over **300 high-tech sensors to** measure temperature and monitor seismic activity.
- 4. The land for the temple was donated by the UAE government.

Right to Disconnect - Australia

- 1. The government of Australia is looking to **pass a Jaw on "Right to Disconnect".**
- 2. It **aims to regulate timings** for when bosses are allowed to contact employees beyond their working hours via phone calls, messages or emails.
- 3. Similar Jaws have already been passed in France, Italy, and Belgium.



- 4. The concept of the 'Right to Disconnect' stems from the recognition that modern technology blurs the **boundaries between work and personal life**.

- 2. They discussed for reviving the so-called Weimar Triangle.
- 3. It is a long-dormant regional grouping that was designed to promote cooperation between France, Germany and Poland.



World's fourth-largest economy

- 1. Japan slips to the world's fourth-largest economy, behind the US, China and now Germany.
- Japan's nominal GDP totalled \$4.2 trillion last year, or about 591 trillion yen.
- 3. The Japanese economy has gradually lost its competitiveness and productivity while the **population shrinks as Japanese people age** and have fewer children.
- 4. Japan fell from the **second-ranked economy behind the U.S.** to the thirdlargest in 2010 as China's economy grew.

Aspides Mission

- 1. The European Union launched a naval mission to **protect Red Sea shipping** from **Yemen's Houthi rebels.**
- 2. Several countries have expressed their intention to participate in this mission, called **Aspides ("shield" in ancient Greek)**'
- 3. This will have orders to **fire on the Houthis** only if they attack first and will not be authorised to shoot pre-emptively.
- Since November, the Houthis have been attacking commercial and military shipping in the busy Red Sea, across which 12% of global trade travels.

Future Circular Collider



1. **CERN**, the European Organization for Nuclear Research, plans to build the **three- times bigger (and faster)** Future Circular Collider (FCC).



- 2. FCC is a **particle accelerator** that will be within a **91 kilometre ring**, which will give it three times the circumference of the **Large Hadron Collider**.
- 3. FCC would only be **operational by 2045** by the very earliest.
- The goal of the FCC is to push energy and intensity frontiers of particle colliders, with the aim of reaching collision energies of 100 tera electron Volts.

GRAPES-3 experiment

- 1. GRAPES-3 experiment researchers have identified a **new characteristic in the cosmic-ray proton spectrum** at an energy level of around **166 tera**eJectron-volt (TeV).
- 2. This observation **introduces a potential shift** in our **understanding of cosmic ray origins**, their acceleration processes, and how they move **within the Milky Way**.
- 3. Cosmic rays discovered over a century ago, represent the universe's most energetic particle.



Indigenous Laser Weapon DURGA-2

- 1. DRDO is preparing to **test a real prototype of its indigenous laser weapon** system, DURGA-2.
- 2. DURGA stands for Directionally Unrestricted Ray Gun Array.
- 3. The present generation of **anti-aircraft or anti-missile systems** are not considered fool-proof.

World's 1st Pigeonpea speed breeding protocol

- The International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-Arid Tropics (ICRISAT) has announced the world's first Pigeonpea Speed Breeding Protocol'.
- 2. These new lines of pigeon pea will be crucial in **bringing food security** in the **drylands of Asia and Africa.**
- 3. The breeding cycle that takes around seven years, can be reduced to twofour years.
- 4. The scientists have successfully restricted vegetative growth and triggered early flowering.
- 5. It is rich in thiamine, riboflavin, niacin, vitamin B-6, folate, vitamin A, calcium, zinc, iron, magnesium and phosphorus.

Frozen Smoke Discovery

- 1. Researchers have developed sensors made from **highly porous materials** known as **'frozen smoke' (aerogels).**
- 2. By precisely engineering the shape of the holes in the **aerogels**, the sensors were able to **detect the fingerprint of formaldehyde** at room temperature.
- 3. Formaldehyde is a **common indoor air pollutant.**
- 4. It uses **artificial intelligence techniques** to detect formaldehyde.
- 5. It is **far beyond the sensitivity** of most indoor air quality sensors.



High-Energy Particle "Amaterasu"

- 1. Scientists have detected an extremely powerful particle with **ultra-high** energy.
- 2. They believed that it has **travelled to Earth** from beyond the **Milky Way** galaxy.
- 3. It has been named the "**sun goddess**" (Amaterasu in Japanese) particle and is extraordinary.
- 4. This particle has an **energy level one million times** greater than what can be generated in most powerful particle accelerators.
- 5. It rivals the single most energetic cosmic ray ever observed, the "Oh-My-God" particle that was detected in 1991.



Water on asteroid

- 1. Researchers for the first time, detected the **presence of water molecules** on the surface of an **asteroid Iris and Massalia**.
- 2. The discovery is based on the analysis of data gathered by **Stratospheric Observatory for Infrared Astronomy** (SOFIA).
- 3. Both Iris and Malissa are **rich in silicates.**
- Iris (with a diametre of 199 km) and Massalia (with a diametre of 135 km) have similar orbits, travelling an average distance of 2.39 astronomical units (AU).



High Altitude Pseudo Satellite Vehicle Swathika

- 1. The National Aerospace Laboratories (NAL) of Bengaluru has successfully flown a prototype of a new-generation unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV).
- 2. This one can **fly at great heights**, about 20 km from ground, runs entirely on **solar power**, and can remain in the air for months on end.
- 3. Such UAVs belong to a class of flying objects called HAPS, or highaltitude pseudo-satellite vehicles, or HALE, that is high-altitude longendurance vehicles.

India's first hypervelocity expansion tunnel test facility

- 1. The Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur (IITK) has successfully built and tested India's first hypervelocity expansion tunnel test facility.
- The facility is capable of generating flight speeds ranging from 3 to 10 km/s, simulating hypersonic conditions.
- 3. It is crucial for various applications such as atmospheric entry of vehicles, asteroid entry, scramjet flights, and ballistic missiles.

1. The International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) has introduced the Species Threat Abatement and Restoration (STAR) metric.



1. **China's fifth scientific** outpost **in the Antarctic**, was officially named as Qinling Station.






