Green Hydrogen Hub Port

- 1. India's first indigenously built hydrogen fuel cell ferry boat, named 'Suchetha', was inaugurated in Kochi.
- 2. The **V.O. Chidambaranar Port** is also the **first Green Hydrogen Hub** Port of the country.

Statues of Various People

- 1. The CM virtually unveiled statue of late Tamil scholar Mu. Varadarasan in Ranipet.
- 2. The statues of late Tamil scholar and freedom fighter **Annal Thango** was unveiled **at Gudiyatham in Vellore district** and late anti-caste activist **Rettaimalai Srinivasan** unveiled at **Acharapakkam in Chengalpattu** district.

- 2. This upcoming facility would have the capacity to **launch 24 satellites** per year.
- 3. When a satellite is launched into space from **ISRO's Sriharikota facility**, the rocket **first heads east, and then turn south**.
- 4. But the satellite launch from Kulasekaranpattinam spaceport doesn't have to take this diversion and the rockets can now head straight in the southern direction.
- 5. Also, Kulasekaranpattinam is closer to the equator than Sriharikota.
- 6. SSLVs can be used to launch satellites that weigh less than 500 kg into the lower earth orbit.

First-ever herpetofaunal survey

- 1. The first-ever herpetofaunal survey was conducted in the Core Area of the Mudumalai Tiger Reserve (MTR).
- 2. The diversity of the region's amphibians and reptiles led to the recording of **82 different species.**



New e-governance initiative of the state

1. Tamil Nadu state has launched the Tamil Nadu Public Fund Tracking System (TNPFTS).



- 3. It also launched the 'Kalanjiyam' portal and a mobile application to facilitate selfservice requirements of State government employees and pensioners.

Kazhuveli watershed region

- 1. The Eri (tank) network in the Kazhuveli watershed region in Villupuram district is to be proposed for nomination to the World Monuments Fund Watch 2025 programme.
- 2. The watershed area stretches from **Gingee to Marakkanam** all the way up to the Auroville plateau, and covers an area of 740 sq. km.
- 3. The Watch 2025 is a **nomination-based programme** that connects **local** heritage preservation to global awareness and action.

HPV vaccination programme

- Chief Minister M.K. Stalin recently inaugurated the HPV vaccination programme at the Adyar Cancer Institute's screening centre in the Villupuram government hospital complex.
- 2. The free vaccination against cervical cancer will cover girls aged **9-14 in Villupuram district.**
- 3. Cervical cancer is mainly caused by human papillomavirus (HPV).

Pudhumai Penn Scheme

49K More Girl Students In TN To Get Rs IK Every Month Over 49,000 more girl students studying in Tamil-Medium in government aided colleges across Tamil Nadu will get a monthly stipend of Rs.1000 in their bank accounts under the Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammaiyar Higher Education Assurance SchemePudhumai Penn Scheme. The state government yesterday issued orders expanding the scheme to the students of aided colleges.

- 1. The government order issued by the Social Welfare Department has expanded the scope of the Pudhurnai Penn Scheme to **students studying through Tamil medium** at aided schools.
- 2. This would benefit over **49,600 more girl students studying** through Tamil medium in aided schools across Tamil Nadu.

Marine Elite Force

1. The **Tamil Nadu Forest Department** has launched a specialised unit called the Marine Elite Force.

2. The unit aims to **preserve and protect marine resources** such as coral reefs, sea grass, and other marine flora and fauna in the eco-sensitive island against exploitation in the **Gulf of Mannar of the Palk Bay**.

Second World Classical Tamil Conference

- 1. Chief Minister M.K. Stalin announced that the **second World Classical Tamil Conference** would be **held in Chennai** in June 2025 for five days.
- 2. The **First World Classical Tamil Conference** was held in **June 2010 in Coimbatore** under the leadership of then Chief Minister M.Karunanidhi.

Impact of Breakfast scheme

- 1. Of the **1,543 government schools** in Tamil Nadu where the Chief Minister's Breakfast Scheme has been rolled out, **1,319 schools showed** an increase in attendance of students of Classes I-V in January and February this year.
- 2. In **Tirupattur, Perambalur, Ariyalur and Tiruvarur**, the attendance at all schools where the scheme is running is **100%**.
- 3. These districts are followed by Krishnagiri (98.5%), Karur (97.4%) and the Nilgiris (96.8%).
- 4. At 1,086 schools, the increase in attendance is up to 20%, while 22 schools report more than 40% increase.

Four New Municipalities

- The State government has ordered that Pudukottai, Namakkal, Tiruvannamalai, and Karaikudi be upgraded to Municipal Corporations.
- 2. The new Municipal Corporations will be established in compliance with the procedures laid down under the **Tamil Nadu Urban Local Bodies** Act,1998.

'Mudhalvarin Grama Salaigal Membattu Thittam' (MGSMT)

- The Tamil Nadu government has recently sanctioned 1,000 crore to improve roads in village panchayats and panchayat unions under this scheme.
- 2. The scheme aims to expand the network of quality roads to remote villages, road development works **covering 2,000 km**.

PM SHRI Schools scheme

- 1. The Tamil Nadu government has decided to sign a **MoU with the Union Education Ministry** to implement the PM SHRI scheme in the state.
- 2. It aims to showcase the **implementation of the National Education Policy 2020** and **emerge as an exemplary school** over a period of time and also offer mentorship to other schools in their vicinity.
- 3. The PM SHRI schools will deliver quality teaching for the cognitive development of students.

Pulikuthi pattangal

- 1. Pulikuthi pattangal which dates back to Vijayanagara Empire was excavated near Kandhili in Tirupattur district.
- 2. It is erected in memory of those who lay their lives while chasing tigers out of residential pockets.

Tamil Nadu emerges as top borrower

- 1. According to ratings firm ICRA Limited, Tamil Nadu emerged as the **top borrowing State for the fourth successive** fiscal year.
- 2. Tamil Nadu is **followed by Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh** in market borrowings.



Land acquisition for Tiger Reserve

1. In a first, the **Tamil Nadu Forest department has acquired 30.41 acres** of erstwhile **private patta land**, situated in the **core area of Srivilliputhur Megamalai Tiger Reserve (SMTR).**



- 2. The land was acquired through private negotiation under the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.
- 3. This is the **first time in India** where the state government has purchased private land for non-commercial use towards forest and biodiversity conservation.

Megalithic burials atop Jawadhu Hills

- 1. TN Archaeology Department officials found over 100 megalithic burials inside Pattarakadu reserve forest (RF) atop Jawadhu Hills in Tiruvannamalai.
- 2. Each burial site, on an average, was **7.5 metres in diameter** and 1.5 metres in height.
- 3. Similar types of megalithic burials without remains were also found in Mallachandram (Krishnagiri) and Coimbatore region.

STATE

Public and Private Property Damage Recovery Bill



- 1. **Uttarakhand govt** will table a bill that **makes rioters** accountable for damages to govt and private property.
- 2. The bill is named as Uttarakhand Public and Private Property Damage Recovery Bill.
- 3. Those guilty of causing riots and other disturbances will be liable to pay compensation under this Bill.
- 4. The **UP govt** passed a similar bill in **2020**.
- 5. **Haryana** also followed suit and **Uttarakhand will be the third state** to enact such a law.

Kyasanur Forest Disease

- 1. **Kamataka** is grappling with the outbreak of **Kyasanur Forest Disease** (KFD), commonly known as **monkey fever.**
- 2. Monkey fever is caused by the Kyasanur Forest disease virus (KFDV), a member of the Flaviviridae virus family.
- 3. The virus was **first identified in 1957** when it was isolated from a **sick monkey** in the Kyasanur Forest of Karnataka.





- 1. The Shahpur Kandi dam on river Ravi in Punjab, bordering Jammu and Kashmir has finally been completed.
- 2. It also comprises two hydropower plants with an installed capacity of 206 MW.

- 4. Ravi is one of the **three eastern rivers** of the **Indus River system** and its water under the **Indus Water Treaty falls** in India's share.
- 5. It will help India better utilise the Ravi waters.

State Energy Efficiency Index 2023

- 1. The State Energy Efficiency Index (SEEI) is a measurement tool **used to assess and compare** the annual energy efficiency performance of different states/ UTs.
- 2. The most improved states in this assessment are Maharashtra and Haryana.
- 3. **Karnataka is top-performer** and **Andhra Pradesh is runner-up** in implementation of energy efficiency policies.
- 4. Chandigarh won this for the second year in a row for its strong commitment to eco-friendly practices for a more energy conscious future.

Lac bangles from Hyderabad



- 1. The Lacquer or lac bangles of Hyderabad got a Geographical Indication tag.
- 2. The bangles of the Laad Bazaar are known for their **dazzling** stonework.


3. Lac bangles are **made of resin which is malleable** with heat and has a **special ability** to **absorb colour.**

Centre for Industrial Revolution

- 1. Hyderabad witnessed the inauguration of the World Economic Forum's (WEF) Centre for Fourth Industrial Revolution (C4IR).
- 2. This is the world's first thematic centre focussed on healthcare and life sciences.
- 3. The C4IR focuses on three key areas: **real-world evidence**, **healthcare** analytics and informatics, and software as a medical device.

Aghanashini Estuary

- 1. Aghanashini River in central **Uttara Kannada district of Karnataka** will be pitched for **Ramsar tag.**
- 2. Aghanashini River originates in the Western Ghats and flows westward towards Arabian Sea and a major part of its course flows through the forested gorges and valleys.
- 3. The other contender in the list is Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary in Mandya district of Karnataka.

State Specific Disaster - Kerala

- 1. Kerala declared man-animal conflict as a state-specific disaster, becoming the **first state in the country** to do so.
- 2. At present, managing man-animal conflict is the **responsibility of the forest department**, which acts as per the Wild Life Protection Act.
- 3. **District collectors** can **directly intervene** in their capacity as the chairman of the district disaster body.
- 4. In 2015, Odisha had declared snakebite a state-specific disaster.
- 5. In **2020**, Kerala declared Covid as a state specific disaster.

Pandavula Gutta

- 1. Pandavula Gutta has been officially recognised as the **sole Geoheritage site** in **Telangana**.
- 2. It is older than the Himalayas and showcases ancient rock paintings in various colours like green, red, yellow, and white.
- 3. The paintings **depict symbols such as swastikas, circles, squares**, and animals like bison, antelope, tiger, and leopard.
- 4. Geo-heritage refers to the geological features which are inherently or culturally significant offering insight into earth's evolution or history to earth science or that can be utilized for education.

India's Oldest Temple

- 1. Archaeological Survey of India (AS) is excavating two mounds in Nachne village, Panna district, Madhya Pradesh, to uncover India's potentially oldest temple.
- 2. The excavation sites are near two ancient temples- a Gupta-era Parvati temple- and close to Chaumukhi temple, built by the Kalachuri Dynasty.
- 3. **Madhya Pradesh** boasts several ancient temples, including the 'Sanchi 17' from the Gupta period, dating back to the 5th century CE.
- 4. This temple is considered the **oldest surviving complete temple** in India till date.
- 5. The excavation team hopes to find pre-Gupta-era temples.

India's Longest Cable-Stayed Bridge

- 1. India's longest cable-stayed bridge was inaugurated in Gujarat's Dwarka.
- 2. The 'Sudarshan Setu' is connecting Okha and Beyt Dwarka island.
- 3. The bridge, which was known as 'Signature Bridge', has been renamed as 'Sudarshan Setu' or Sudarshan Bridge.

India's first-ever dolphin research centre

- Bihar Chief Minister inaugurated India's first-ever dolphin research centre - National Dolphin Research Center (NDRC) in Patna.
- 2. It is situated on the **banks of the Ganges** inside the Patna University campus.

SAKHI App

- 1. The **Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre** (VSSC) has developed a multipurpose app named 'SAKHI'.
- 2. SAKHI stands for 'Space-borne Assistant and Knowledge Hub for Crew Interaction'
- 3. It will help astronauts on the Gaganyaan space flight mission carry out a range of tasks such as looking up vital technical information or communicating with one another.
- 4. SAKHI will also keep a **close watch on their health like blood pressure**, heart rate and oxygen saturation.

- 2. The 22nd Law Commission headed by Justice Ritu Raj
 Awasthi.
- 3. **Trade secrets** are intellectual property rights on confidential information that may be sold or licensed.

KIRTI Program

- 1. The **Khelo India Rising Talent Identification (KIRTI)** programme was launched recently .
- 2. The scheme is aimed at school children in the age group of nine to 18 years.
- 3. It will also focus on using sports as a **tool for healthy life** and primarily keep youngsters away from drugs and gadgetry distractions.
- 4. Fifty thousand applicants were being assessed in the first phase across 10 sports.

50 years of Chipko Movement

- 1. The Chipko movement, which began in **Uttarakhand (Chamoli Gopeshwar)** in **early 1973**, marks its 50th anniversary.
- 2. It involved villagers, particularly women, protesting against deforestation and commercial logging by hugging trees to prevent their felling.
- 3. The movement was named Chipko, which means "to hug" in Hindi.

- Researchers have developed miniature robots using human cells capable of both movement and healing neurons within a laboratory setting.
- 2. They are termed as 'Anthrobots'.
- 3. These bioengineered entities consist of human tracheal cells and possess the ability to autonomously configure themselves into various forms and dimensions.
- 4. These biobots can be used as the innovative instruments for the purposes of regeneration, recovery, and the management of diseases.

ENVIRONMENT

Single Species Action Plan: CMS COP14

- 1. CMS COP14 adopted the **Single Species Action Plan** for the conservation of the **Hawksbill Turtle**.
- 2. It is developed under the Agreement on the Conservation of African-Eurasian Migratory Waterbirds (AEWA).
- 3. Hawksbill Turtle is classified as **Critically Endangered** by the **IUCN Red List.**

Cheetah Population in Kuno National Park

- 1. In Kuno National Park in **Madhya Pradesh**, India, the population of **Indian-born cheetahs** has **reached 13**, with the recent addition of **five cubs born to South African Cheetah Gamini**.
- 2. The total cheetah population, including cubs, now stands at 26.
- 3. This is marking a significant achievement for India's conservation project.

4. **Eight Namibian cheetahs** arrived at Kuno National Park on **September 17, 2022.**

Microalgae adaptation to warming

- 1. The **Microalgae**, which form the base of the **food chain in the ocean** and capture carbon dioxide from the atmosphere, appear to rely on a unique strategy to cope with global warming.
- 2. As the climate change reduces the availability of nutrients in the sea, marine microalgae or eukaryotic phytoplankton fire up a protein called Rhodopsin.
- 3. It is related to the protein in the human eye responsible for vision in dim light.
- 4. This light-responsive protein is helping the microalgae flourish with the help of sunlight in place of traditional chlorophyll.
- 5. They may absorb as much light as **chlorophyll-based photosynthesis** in the sea, which also captures light to generate energy and food.

FARM Program

- 1. The Financing Agrochemical Reduction and Management Programme (FARM) to combat agrochemical pollution.
- 2. It is **Funded** by the **Global Environment Facility**; the programme is led by UNEP.
- 3. It seeks to change that, elaborating the business case for banks and policy- makers to reorient policy and financial resources towards farmers.
- 4. These resources will help them **adopt low and non-chemical alternatives** to **toxic agrochemicals** and facilitate a transition towards better practices.

Khelo India Winter Games 2024

- 1. The Khelo India Winter Games 2024 was conducted in **two phases.**
